The Silver Mountain Electronic Targets System will be used for both Championship matches. A class will be given on the Electronic Target system (monitors) on the firing line at 7:45 AM on Sat. Sept 24 and Wed. Sept 28. Attendance is mandatory.

RANGE LOCATION: Winnequah Gun Club, approximately three miles north of Lodi WI. Take I-90/94 West to Exit 115; turn right onto County Road CS (0.2 miles); turn left at County Road J (1.1 mile); turn right at County Road J at the T in the road (3.3 mile). Look for Winnequah Gun Club sign and Indoor Range on your left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. The club address is W10219 Larson Dr., Lodi WI 53555. Camping is permitted and the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Thursday, September 22. If camping see the Stat Officer for a camping site – indicate on entry form.

RULES: Current NRA F-Class Rules shall apply.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to anyone.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA F Class Prone classification and NRA membership number. Those competitors unclassified or without proof of a lower classification will be required to compete in the Master class. Mail individual entry form with correct fees to:

Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00 pm, Friday September 19, 2016. There will be no refunds for those canceling after that time.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 6:00 pm Friday, September 16, 2016. Entries after this time are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only. An additional \$20.00 will be charged for late entries. Individual entries are limited to 192 competitors, and 32 Teams.

TARGET SERVICE: Competitors **WILL NOT** pull targets. **NO MORE BUS RIDE!**

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): Approved NRA empty chamber indicators are required to be used at all times except during the preparation period time and firing. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the Stat Office for \$1.00 each.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Scorecards for individual matches will be issued at the Stat Office starting at approximately 6:30 am. Any competitor who fails to obtain his scorecards by 7:30 am will only be squadded to fill up vacancies.

SCORING: With the Electronic Target system competitors are still required to score. Any competitors failing to perform his scoring duties may be disqualified. Personal Smart phones or Kindle laptops can be used for scoring.

DIVISION BY RIFLE: F-Open and F-TR.

AWARDS: Medals and cash awards will be given. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place etc. awards will be given based on one award for every seven (7) competitors, i.e second 8-14, third 15-21, etc.

SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: In the grand aggregate a High Junior, High Woman, High Senior, and High Grand Senior award will be given if there are 5 or more entries.

CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends ½ hour after the posting of the match results.
